CRADLE CROSS

The cradle cross on the altar today is in honor of Vera Virginia Adalyn Berlanga, born December 24, 2023 to Lauren and Warren Berlanga, and the grandchild of José and Polly Berlanga and Marshall and Cindy Reid.

A cradle cross was placed on the West Campus altar in celebration of Connor William Gaden, born April 9, 2024, son of John Thomas and 'Amy Gaden and grandson of Tom and Kathy Gaden.

ALTAR FLOWERS

On April 10, 1839, it was announced in the Telegraph and Texas Register that "Reverend Jesse Hord, minister of the Methodist Episcopal Church will preach in the senate chamber of the capital [in Houston], on Sabbath, 14th April, at which time a church will be organized by said minister." This was the first Methodist congregation established in

Houston. Reverend Hord wrote in his personal journal "Our church or class in this populous city numbers fourteen, joined by letter." The Sanctuary flowers are given by Ellen and Gary Hickman to honor our church, recognized as the first to organize and establish Methodism in Houston 185 years ago on this date, April 14, 1839.
