

# Nicaragua Mission Trip July 22-29, 2017

#### ITINERARY (tentative)

**Saturday, July 22nd:** Meet at Intercontinental Airport, for morning flight to Managua on United Airlines. We will be picked up by the ministry leader at airport with school bus. Transport to La Quinta Havilah (Open Hearts Base). Have lunch and settle in. Afternoon briefing, drive to see project area, prepare projects for the week. Dinner and worship.

**Sunday, July 23rd:** Breakfast, quiet time. Church and morning program. Lunch at La Quinta. Afternoon outreach. Dinner and worship.

**Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup>-Thursday, July 27<sup>th</sup>**: Breakfast, quiet time, outreaches: work projects, evangelism outreaches and VBS. Dinner and worship each night.

**Friday, July 25**<sup>th</sup>: Breakfast and quiet time. Depart for San Juan del Sur to the beach for lunch, swimming and shopping. Dinner at La Quinta Havilah and closing worship.

**Saturday, July 26<sup>th</sup>**: Breakfast, guiet time. Load bus for airport. Flight to Houston

#### HOUSING AND TRANSPORTATION

We will be staying at the Open Hearts mission base, called La Quinta Havilah, in Managua. It is a beautiful acreage with small cottages for men and women with areas for eating and worship. There is a nice swimming pool for free time. Girls must wear shorts over their one piece bathing suits. You will need to bring a towel for the pool and the beach.

United Airlines flight and school bus in country. If you have a Mileage Plus account, bring your card with you when you check in to earn miles.

#### COST

The cost is \$1600 per person. It includes airfare, housing, ground transportation, visa, departure taxes, medical insurance and most meals.

\$200	Deposit and application due upon registration (deposit is non-refundable)
\$500	First Payment due March 1 <sup>st</sup>
\$500	Second Payment due May 1 <sup>st</sup>

\$400 Final balance due June 15<sup>th</sup>

#### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

☐ Mission Trip Registration Forms (pages 1-3)
□ Medical Release (FMH pages 4,5)
□ Passport check expiration date – <b>MUST EXPIRE AFTER JANUARY 22, 2018; RENEW IF EARLIER</b>
□ Color copy of your passport
☐ Copy of your health insurance (You will be covered for international medical and emergency insurance.)

#### **IMMUNIZATIONS**

Check with your doctor for their recommendation on vaccinations for Managua, Nicaragua. Don't usually recommend malaria prevention, as we are in populated areas.

#### Vaccines:

Tetanus: required

Hepatitis A & B: recommended

#### MONEY

You will need money for 2 meals in the airport and 1 meal at the beach and any snacks and small souvenirs that you wish to bring home. Please remember to carry cash only, NO CREDIT CARDS or Travelers Checks. Small bills are best - \$1, 5, 10 and 20 bills. (Recommend a minimum of \$50 in cash for meals and snacks) There is a coffee shop at the ministry base, which sells coffee and souvenirs.

#### DRINKING WATER

La Quinta Havilah has its own water well and we will have fresh, clean water. You will fill your water bottles each day and we will have large water coolers with fresh water, as well. You may drink from the sink at La Quinta Havilah and use the water for brushing teeth, etc. Do not drink water from other sources.

#### VALUABLES

We recommend that you do not bring valuables, such as laptops, IPads, jewelry or other items. La Quinta Havilah has a full time security guard and a safe to lock up our passports and things but it is best to leave expensive items at home, unless you are on the AV team.

#### LUGGAGE REQUIREMENTS

The size limitation of your luggage is calculated by adding the total outside dimensions of each bag (length + width + height). One checked bag at 62in/157cm. Maximum weight: 40lbs. We will ask you to carry some additional supplies. One carry-on bag at 45in/114cm.
